IF YOU'RE A JEEP OR ROCK BUGGY OWNER- YOU NEED TO BE HERE...!

NO ALCOHOL will be allowed or sold on event grounds.

Please check the web site for camping and hotel links as there is no camping on event grounds.

NO PETS will be allowed on the event grounds.

Admission for spectators is \$5.00 per person. 12 & Under are Free.

To participate in any of the course events – you must be a licensed driver over the age of 18. (Per insurance regulations) Passengers must be over the age of 18 to participate on the moderate or extreme rock course.

Obstacle Course Rules & Regulations - Event “Code of Ethics”

The Citrus County Jeepers Club is your “host” this weekend and has formulated the following to see that each and every person in attendance understands what is expected of you. We look for everyone to experience our entertainment, and friendships that will be carried on long into the future since many of us will cross paths again sometime, somewhere.

ALL JEEPS/ROCK BUGGIES WILL BE INSPECTED UPON ENTRY TO ENSURE SAFETY

Driver & Passengers Obstacle Course “Code of Ethics”:

- 1) Everyone **MUST** wear their wristbands at **ALL** times during the event.
- 2) Seat belts are **MANDATORY** at **ALL** times for everyone in the Jeep/Rock Buggy.
- 3) Keep hands and feet inside the Jeep/Rock Buggy at **ALL** times during the event.
- 4) Watch and listen to the “spotters”. They are here to help and instruct.
- 5) Tow points front and/or rear are highly recommended.
WITHOUT TOW POINTS SPOTTERS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY POSSIBLE RECOVERY DAMAGE
- 6) Battery tie downs are **MANDATORY**. Bungee cords are **NOT** acceptable.

Obstacle Course - Stock - Requirements:

Stock course is open to all road legal driven Jeeps.

- 1) Tow points front and/or rear are highly recommended.

Obstacle Course - Moderate - Requirements:

- 1) Tow points front and/or rear are required.

WITHOUT TOW POINTS SPOTTERS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY POSSIBLE RECOVERY DAMAGE

- 2) Battery tie downs are MANDATORY. Bungee cords are NOT acceptable.
- 3) At least one locker is highly recommended for moderate course
- 3) Winch is recommended not required

Obstacle Course - BIG ROCK EXTREME course – Requirements:

VEHICLE DAMAGE IS POSSIBLE – ENTER THIS SECTION AT YOUR OWN RISK

- 1) Minimum 37” Tires and lockers front & rear are required.
- 2) Tow points front & rear for recovery.
- 3) Battery tie downs are MANDATORY.
- 4) To run the Extreme Course we advised that all occupants wear a Helmet! But this is not mandatory.
- 5) **Must have an operable winch.**

If you find that you are unable to remove your jeep/buggy from the course due to mechanical failure, CCJ reserves the right to remove your vehicle using heavy equipment such as a tractor or track hoe, etc. CCJ is not responsible for any damages that incur to you or your vehicle during the removal process.

We've constructed these obstacle courses for everyone's enjoyment during our Show. These rules and regulations are in place to ensure everyone's safety and enjoyment. ANY violators shall be given ONE warning prior to being ejected from the event without refund.

Category Identification:

All modifications are based on after-market and custom work & products, NOT factory delivered options.

Determine the category your Jeep/Buggy falls into by counting and listing the total number of;

MINOR Modifications - MAJOR Modifications

**NOTE: It is YOUR responsibility to be honest with your Jeep/Buggy installed modifications
Deliberate deceit WILL be disqualified from voting**

- Determine the number of modifications done to your Jeep, they will place it under one of the following categories.

“STOCK” – A maximum of two Minor Modifications with NO Major Modifications.

“MODIFIED” – A maximum of three Major Modifications with NO limit on Minor Modifications

“UNLIMITED” - Four or more Major Modifications – **PLACES YOU HERE!**

- Determine the classification and category – Mail the registration form to the address listed on the registration form.

Additional Awards Recognized:

“Best of Show”

One Awarded for EACH Category of (STOCK / MODIFIED / UNLIMITED)

“The BEST restored / modified Jeep as determined by your peer voters”.

“Best Trail Ready”

“The best Jeep built and prepared to conquer any off-road obstacles”

“The Ultimate Beater”

“The Jeep that has taken a beating and keeps on going”

“Largest Club Participation”

The Club with the most members with **registered** Jeeps/Rock Buggies within the Event will receive the Largest Club Participation Award.

“Longest Distance Traveled”

The **Jeep** that is driven the longest distance to participate in our Event shall be awarded the Longest Distance Traveled Award. **Your Jeep MUST have been driven the entire distance, NO TRAILERS**

YOU MUST SIGN IN AT THE REGISTRATION BOOTH – YOUR VOTING NUMBER IS REQUIRED

NOTE: All “Peer Voted” classes should be judged based on the number of modifications made to the Jeep based on its Classification - Not to exclude: **(1)** Trail readiness **(2)** The ability to conquer off-road terrain **(3)** Appearance of the Jeep **ALSO:** Stereo systems, alarm systems, telephones, and other similar electronic devices are **NOT** to be part of the voting criteria.

CITRUS COUNTY JEEPERS shall NOT be responsible for miswritten or illegible voting ballots and reserves FINAL decision

(See the Show Chairman and Club President to settle any/all disputes)

Event “Tread Lightly” Expectations:

- 1) Pack out what you pack in. I.E.: Jeep parts, chairs, clothing, and anything else.
- 2) Trash containers are throughout the facility, please make use of them.
- 3) Keep your Jeep/Rock Buggy and/or personal property within your show-field parking boundary.
- 4) Citrus County Jeepers & Horse Hole Creek are not responsible for valuables left in vehicles during event
- 5) Respect your show-field neighbors, event staff, vendors, and fellow participants.
